Security lighting and power supply

Criminals don't like to be seen!

Some crimes and offences are committed at night, however the presence of lighting can cause problems for offenders because they can be seen.

Keeping your home or business well lit with security lights is one of the simplest steps you can take to protect your property.

Protecting your power supply

It is pointless having effective security lighting if the power supply can be interrupted at the flick of a switch.

A simple way of protecting your power supply by fitting an approved meter box with a lock and a viewing window. It will make it much harder for a criminal to cut your power.
