



# Keeping your car safe

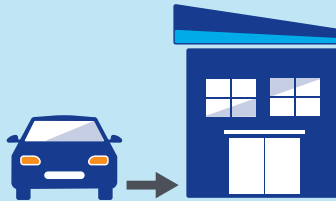


## Park your car in a safe place

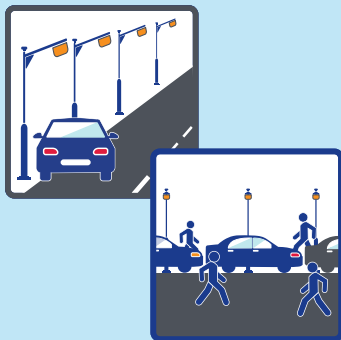
You should always park your car in a safe place, such as:

Don't leave valuable items in your car.



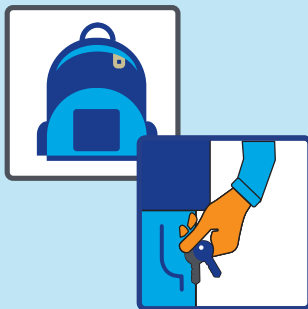
Valuable items include your:
